



CODE OF ETHICS

SECTION I: The active members of this chapter shall be limited to those persons and firms who shall subscribe to the following code of Ethics.

- A. Members of the NAHB Chapter of Washtenaw County believe and affirm that:
 - 1. Home ownership can and should be within the reach of every American family.
 - 2. American homes should be well designed, well constructed and well located in attractive communities, within educational, recreational, religious and shopping facilities, accessible to all.
 - 3. American homes should be built under the free American enterprise system.

- B. To achieve these goals, we pledge alliance to the following principals and policies.
 - 1. Our paramount responsibility is to our customers, our community and our country.
 - 2. Honesty is our guiding business policy.
 - 3. High standards of health, safety and sanitation shall be built into every home.
 - 4. Members shall deal fairly with their respective employees, sub-contractors and suppliers.
 - 5. As members of a progressive industry, we encourage research to develop new materials, new building techniques, new building equipment and improved methods of home financing, to the end that every home purchaser may get the greatest value possible for every dollar.
 - 6. All sound legislative proposals affecting our industry and the people we serve shall have our informed and vigorous support
 - 7. We hold inviolate the free enterprise system and the American way of life. We pledge our support to our associates, our local State and National Association and all related industries concerned with preservation of legitimate rights and freedoms.
